North Arlington Pediatrics Vaccination Policy

- All new families to North Arlington Pediatrics must receive all vaccines recommended by the AAP that are mandated for school entry by the State of Illinois. http://www.dph.illinois.gov/topics-services/prevention-wellness/immunization
- 2. All children must begin receiving their immunizations at 2 months and be up-to-date on all required vaccines (including MMR and Varicella) by the age of 2 years.
- Patients must use the immunizations schedule recommended by the CDC and AAP unless there
 is a medical reason (religious or philosophical exemptions will not be accepted):

- 4. Parents or caregivers who do not agree with North Arlington Pediatrics vaccine policy will be given a 1 month grace period to find another pediatric practice. Please recognize that by not vaccinating your child or using alternative or delayed vaccine schedules, you are putting your child and others at unnecessary risk of life-threatening illness and disability, even death.
- 5. North Arlington Pediatrics will not continue to complete WIC forms for families who are not current on vaccines unless they agree to an approved "catch-up" schedule.
